Report of the event:

On 29th April 2024, Centre for Research (CFR), in collaboration with the Advisory Committee for Professional Grooming (ACPG) organized a workshop on "Research Methodology" at NSB Seminar Hall, Maitreyi College. The workshop started with the felicitation of the guest speaker, Prof. Shobha Bagai by Dr Pinkey Bajaj Gandhi. Dr Gopi Devdutt Tripathy took a moment to give a brief introduction about the primary objectives of the Research Methodology Workshop.

The workshop comprised of three sessions. Session 1 commenced with an engaging lecture on 'Navigating Research Methodology for Undergraduate Students' by Prof. Shobha Bagai. The highlights of her talk were the significance of comprehending the term 'Research', the key differences between research method and methodology, and the delineation of the steps involved in research methodology. To engage students in the session, they were assigned group activity/discussion to identify the research questions about Maitreyi College. Interestingly, Prof. Bagai's discourse on research methodology was relevant to students of all disciplines viz. sciences, social sciences and humanities. The session concluded with pertinent questions asked by students and faculty members.

The speaker for session 2, Dr Neeraj Kumar spoke on the theme, "Quest for Scientific Knowledge and Morality". Dr Kumar's presentation discussed critical aspects of research ethics and its significance in maintaining the integrity of the scholarly work. Using interesting anecdotes, he emphasized the importance of addressing the plagiarism issue seriously. Additionally, he provided a detailed explanation of citations and references done in the research.

The workshop's third session led by Dr Tejendra Kumar was a hands-on session on "Fundamental Statistical Analysis and its Application". The objective of conducting this session was to train students to utilise the advanced statistical analysis software, SPSS effectively in their research work. He discussed the advantages of effective data management using SPSS software which allows its users to analyse unstructured data to extract relevant information.
